With more than 800 caring team members, over 20 locations, and a legacy of caring since the early 1800s, we continue to work toward our vision of a world in which every person is safe and connected to a strong family and a healthy community. Our broad continuum of care means that families can access services from the least intensive, community-based care to intensive children's mental health residential treatment programs.
